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We provide accommodation and support to vulnerable and homeless people who have difficulties sustaining a tenancy. This includes people with complex needs, offenders, those at risk of offending, asylum seekers and people with mental health problems.

Empowering our clients to achieve independence is our end goal.  $\blacktriangledown$ 



## **Sheffield**

#### Offender and Complex needs Project-

Target Offender Project works with individuals who have an offending background or are at risk of offending. We work with individuals who often have multiple and complex needs helping them to sustain a tenancy. Target works in a psychological informed environment and support is tailored to the individuals needs. We use a multi agency approach and support workers guide individuals towards independent living and integration into their community.

#### **Mental Health Project-**

Targets Mental Health service is part of the Mental Health Recovery Framework, we are a council approved provider for mental health support across the city. We provide both supported accommodation and outreach. Our supported accommodation includes both long term and short term accommodation. Our outreach work includes supporting service users living in the community across Sheffield.

# **South Yorkshire Project**

The South Yorkshire Project currently consists of 3 separate and very different projects in Sheffield, Rotherham and Doncaster. All projects provide accommodation for vulnerable adults and families who have either become homeless or have previously struggled to maintain a tenancy and require support to succeed.

In Sheffield, the South Yorkshire Project are working in partnership with IDAS (Independent Domestic Abuse Service) to provide emergency temporary accommodation to people fleeing domestic abuse. The service is aimed at supporting GBT+ (gay, bisexual, trans, and all minority sexual and gender identities) male victims of domestic abuse as well as single women who have multiple and complex needs and for whom Sheffield's refuges would not be suitable.

Similar to Sheffield, in Rotherham, we are working with Rotherham Rise, a support service for adults and children who have been affected by domestic abuse, to provide emergency temporary accommodation for domestic abuse survivors.

In Doncaster we have partnered with Doncaster MBC to provide a Housing First initiative. Target will be providing dispersed single accommodation to clients within the complex lives cohort in Doncaster

## **Rotherham**

#### **Rotherham Housing First -**

Target Housing works in partnership with South Yorkshire Housing Association to offer accommodation and support to individuals with multiple and complex support needs. It provides a stable, independent home and offers intensive personalised support to individuals with a history of entrenched and repeat homelessness.

#### Rotherham Offender service -

Offering supported accommodation to homeless individuals with a history of offending or who are at risk of offending. The project offers fully furnished single or shared accommodation across the Rotherham Borough. Support workers help individuals to identify their support needs and enable them to work towards an independent and crime free life style.

#### Rotherham Link -

Offering supported accommodation throughout Rotherham to single people, couples and families who are currently homeless or who are facing homelessness. Support workers offer support to help address the issues that may be preventing them from sustaining their own tenancy.

#### **Queens Street Project-**

The Queen Street Project provides short term accommodation for those at risk of rough sleeping in the Rotherham area. The project is jointly managed by RMBC and Target housing. Residents are assisted to move on to more secure accommodation, assisted with life skills and also given intensive wrap around support tailored to their needs.

## **Doncaster**

Our Doncaster Project provides supported accommodation to single individuals with complex and multiple needs, who have been or are at risk of homelessness. This support is tailored to individual's specific needs and works in partnerships with other key agencies to deliver an adaptive and responsive approach. The service works to enable individuals to become more independent and move away from factors that may have led to homelessness. All referrals are made through the Doncaster Single Point of Access.

# Partnership

St Martin in the Fields is a church based charity in central London. Target Housing is one of 14 regional partner organisations which form the St Martin in the Field partner Network- The Frontline Network. Launched in 2016 the network aims to raise awareness of the issues and lobbying the government to take positive action. The network provides frontline workers the opportunity to attend events, network, contribute to national media and apply for grants.

### Hull

Target Hull offers supported housing to homeless families and those at risk of homelessness through our partnerships with both private landlords and RSL's. The families, referred to us by Hull City Council, are often dealing with prior tenancy sustainment issues, domestic violence, child protection, drug/ alcohol or mental health issues. When families feel able to successfully manage the tenancy themselves, we negotiate with the landlord to sign over the tenancy to the family.

#### **Hull EU Migrants Project-**

We offer support to help individuals apply for suitable housing and aid them to settle in to their new home and with all matters regarding a tenancy and adapting into their new community. Anyone who lives in Hull can access this service as long as they are an EL Migrant. It does not matter if you rent your home, are staying with friends or family or own your own home. This service is FREE because we are funded by the Big Lottery.

#### Victoria Avenue Project-

Victoria Avenue offers accommodation and support for adults with learning disabilities. The project consists of shared and self-contained accommodation, with a support package tailored to individual needs. Tenants have the opportunity to have their own tenancy and develop their living skills, with the aim of moving towards more independence.

# Asylum

We pride ourselves on providing housing, holistic and persor centred support throughout the asylum journey. We work across South Yorkshire, Hull, North Notts and Derby. Our 'wraparound services include advice, signposting and advocacy, on issues such as housing, education, training, employment, budgeting and health Working with partners we offer accredited ESOL, therapeutic support and short-term workshops

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
